

## YARD WASTE DISPOSAL REQUIREMENTS

Any debris resulting from work performed by a contractor (landscaper, tree service, etc.) must be removed by the contractor and not left at the curb as the City will not pick up debris left by a contractor.

- 1. Per the City Ordinance Sec.50-36 D. Excessive accumulations of trash such as trees, limbs, and branches shall be removed by the owner.
- 2. Any limbs longer than four feet and more than 6 inches in diameter will not be collected and must be removed by the property owner at their expense.
- All tree removals requires a permit from Clermont's Development Service's Department located at City Hall, 685 W. Montrose Street. All tree debris must be removed by the property owner at their expense.
- 4. All other small materials (leaves, bushes, etc.) should be bagged. Bags should not weigh more than 50 lbs. each and should be neatly stacked by the curb at least 4 feet away from any objects such as mailboxes, water meters and low hanging branches.
- 5. All yard trash will be collected on your normal trash day by a different truck.
